Arts & Crafts Club is our highly popular Maidenhead based club that offers young people, aged between 14 & 25, on the spectrum the chance to meet like-minded people, make friends and boost social skills and confidence.

We need a club leader, preferably with an understanding of autism spectrum disorders and some experience of supporting young people. The job is 6.25 hours per fortnight. The sessions themselves run from 14.00-16.30, plus setting up and closing down time (4.25 hours). In between sessions you will have 2 hours to plan and prepare engaging arts and crafts activities. Pay rate is £12 per hour.

There may be an opportunity for additional hours on a Saturday in the future.
